Fashion and Metal Fittings for Sub-Roman British and Early Anglo-Saxon Elites (2 hours)

Class Description: If there was a historical King Arthur, this is what he wore.

This class details how elements of fashion in Late Roman Britain were integral to the presentation of class and ethnicity, and how the Roman Aesthetic of power was subsequently appropriated by Sub-Roman British states and Early Anglo-Saxon Kingdoms in their own attempts to use recognizable symbols to legitimize their power. Through understanding the context of how fashion accessories (mostly brooches and belt buckles) were used to signal authority, prestige and political allegiance, it is possible to make informed decisions about selecting jewelry appropriate to the specific time and place for personas in Britain between the 4th and 6th centuries.

YOU WILL NEED TO BRING an embroidery hoop, about a half-yard scrap of solid color fabric, needles, scissors, and four colors of embroidery floss. (I will have a few hoops for those who sign up during the event.)

This class is suitable for anyone with some previous experience in hand embroidery. (Please don't bring a finished tunic; this is so much easier and quicker before sewing!)
